

Summary of International Webinar on Renewable Energy and Its Audit

International Centre for Environment & Sustainable Development Audit (iCED), the Global Training Facility (GTF) of INTOSAI Working Group on Environmental Auditing (WGEA) conducted International Webinar on "Renewable Energy and its Audit" in two batches on 06th September (06:30 AM to 09:45 AM UTC) and 07th September (11:30 AM to 02:45 PM UTC), 2021. The Webinar was conducted entirely on the virtual platform, attended by highest number of participants. Total 173 participants from 31 SAIs participated in the webinar.

Mr. Shirish Garud, Senior Fellow, TERI (India) underlined the importance of overall agenda, significance of implementation strategy/framework, status/facts and challenges. While discussing the concepts, expert drew on global and Indian examples to highlight importance of SDGs-7 on affordable and clean energy and linkages with Paris agreement and INDC of India.

They explored a number of issues such as overall strategy for renewable energy and SDGs, renewable energy and rural development, Environmental impacts, renewable energy mix in overall energy consumption, achievement of renewable energy targets, storage etc. While discussing the repots they also discussed audit approach and audit objective for each audit.

Mr. Mark Gaffigan and Mr. Frank Rusco, U.S. Government Accountability Office, USA shared the Auditing experience of Renewable Energy in USA. During the session they also highlighted the Audit findings and effectiveness of Tax Expenditure in 2015, Audit of Department of Defense (DOD), Renewable Energy

Projects in 2016, Audit of Status of Residential Deployment of solar and other technologies in 2017, Audit of Energy Storage's role in Grid Operations and Challenges to Deployment in 2018 and Science & Tech Spotlight- Renewable Ocean Energy in 2021.

Mr. Bibhudatta Basantia, SAI India explained the concepts of SDGs, Global overview: status of renewable energy usage, UNFCCC and its principles, approach for SDGs implementation in India, schemes/programmes/interventions/targets National Action Plan for Climate Change. He also discussed about the audit methodology, audit objectives, Criteria and audit findings i.e Gap between target and achievements, potential and installed capacity, implementation of Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) in renewable energy sector, Grid connectivity etc.
